Maximizing Learning. Children feel more committed to an activity they have chosen themselves. Therefore, their attention span will likely be longer if they choose an activity than if they work at a task assigned by the teacher (Fromberg, 1995; Maxim, 1997). Making choices helps children learn persistence and task completion.

Aspects related to learning and well-being included children's self-concept (positive feelings are linked to concrete achievements), autonomy and agency (opportunities to make choices in everyday situations and stable secure relationships with adults), and activities (opportunities to increase mastery and capacity to do things).

Opportunity Cost This concept of scarcity leads to the idea of opportunity cost. The opportunity cost of an action is what you must give up when you make that choice. Another way to say this is: it is the value of the next best opportunity. Opportunity cost is a direct implication of scarcity.

Encourage cooperative learning choices. Set up situations where children can accomplish tasks alone, or let them determine that it's easier to do the project with others (e.g. dumping the water tub). Read books such as "The Three Little Pigs," in which characters make choices.
