They should both be replaced at the same time for optimal cleaning, and this should be done at approximately 15K miles.

Diesel engines have at least three coolers, the oil and fuel coolers, the heat exchanger, and probably also a transmission cooler. All need inspection and service at least once a year. There will be pencil anodes in the raw water side of the system to protect these coolers from internal corrosion, and these should be checked annually, or your heat exchanger could be eaten up by corrosion.
