Response To Production Of Documents

This request is called a Request for Production. In addition to requesting documents, the other side might request to inspect or photograph other pieces of evidence. To respond, you first need to read each request and see if the document or object requested is in your possession, custody, or control.

How to Respond to a Request for Production (with Pictures)

The easiest and non-controversial response is when the responding party has agreed to produce all documents for production without objection.

Common mistakes and pitfalls in responses to Requests for ...

The response may state an objection to a requested form for producing electronically stored information. If the responding party objects to a requested form—or if no form was specified in the request—the party must state the form or forms it intends to use. How To Respond To Requests for Production of Documents “Requests for production” are written demands, usually requiring the other side to produce copies of documents he possesses or can readily obtain. But the requests could be broader too. They could request to inspect or test some item.

Responding To The Other Side's Requests For Information ...

(B) Responding to a request for production of electronically stored information. The response may state an objection to a requested form for producing electronically stored information. If the responding party objects to a requested form - or if no form was specified in the request - the party shall state the form or forms it intends to use.

Civil Procedure Rule 34: Producing documents ...

End with a position on production/response ... It requires the production of electronic documents or records that are not reasonably accessible or for which the cost of production would be unreasonable so as to make the request unduly burdensome and oppressive.

Practice Guidance: Objections to Discovery Requests ...

(d) If a party objects to the discovery of electronically stored information on the grounds that it is from a source that is not reasonably accessible because of undue burden or expense and that the responding party will not search the source in the absence of an agreement with the demanding party or court order, the responding party shall identify in its response the types or categories of ...

RESPONSE TO DOCUMENT REQUEST NO. 4: Plaintiff objects to this document request to the extent it seeks production of documents protected by the work product doctrine, the governmental deliberative process privilege, or the attorney-client privilege.

United States' Objections and Responses to Defendant's ...

The California Code of Civil Procedure now requires “ [a]ny documents or category of documents produced in response to a demand for inspection, copying, testing, or sampling shall be identified with the specific request number to which the documents respond.” Cal. Civ. Pro. § 2031.280 (a). This is a major departure from the prior rule.

CCP 2031.280(a): New Document Production Obligations in ...

For documents in a client’s “custody or control” but not in a client’s possession, the response should note what records are available and where they can be produced. For example, a request to produce “All Defendant’s medical records for the past three years” might be met with a response, “Response: None in Defendant’s possession. Records may be obtained from Dr. Joseph Wilson, 123 Calhoun Street, Charleston, SC 29401.

Best practices in responding to requests for production ...

Responding party is not relieved of their obligations because they believe propounding party has the documents. See C.C.P. § § 2031.210, 2031.220, 2031.230 and 2031.240 The exception is if the responsive

documents have previously been produced in discovery by the responding party.

WHY THESE OBJECTIONS ARE GARBAGE | Resolving Discovery ...

Responses to requests for production are due within 30 days (5 days in unlawful detainer actions) if the requests were personally served, 35 days if the requests were served by mail, and 30 days plus 2 court days if the requests were served by express mail or facsimile or electronically. CCP § 2031.260 (a) (amended eff 6/29/09); CCP § 1013

Responses to Requests for Production - California Los ...

(a) On receipt of a response to a demand for inspection, copying, testing, or sampling, the demanding party may move for an order compelling further response to the demand if the demanding party deems that any of the following apply: (1) A statement of compliance with the demand is incomplete.

California Code, Code of Civil Procedure - CCP § 2031.310 ...

You may ask the opposing party to produce documents, tangible things, and electronically-stored information ("ESI"), and to permit you to enter land or property. See Maryland Rule 2-422 (a). The Rules do not set a limit on the number of documents you may request. However, you should be reasonable in your requests.

2031.280. (a) Any documents or category of documents produced in response to a demand for inspection, copying, testing, or sampling shall be identified with the specific request number to which the documents respond.

Codes Display Text - California

Subject to any objections stated in the response, the responding party must produce the requested documents or tangible things within the person's possession, custody or control at either the time and place requested or the time and place stated in the response, unless otherwise agreed by the parties or ordered by the court, and must provide the requesting party a reasonable opportunity to inspect them.

SB 370: New document identification requirement in all active cases SB 370 provides that "[a]ny documents or category of documents produced in response to a demand for inspection, copying, testing, or sampling shall be identified with the specific request number to which the documents respond."
