The Effectiveness of Independent Reading and Self-Selected ...

Independent reading provides students with an opportunity to practice the decoding and comprehension strategies and skills learned during class time on self-selected materials. Not only does independent reading provide additional practice time for students, but it also fosters independence (Johnson & Keire, 2010).

Strategies and Structures to Support Independent Reading ...

In my classroom, independent reading is the time that students are reading on their own during reading workshop or reading instruction. This means that the students are working on a specific skill or strategy that was taught and discussed in class, and are now trying it out in their own, self-selected, just right book. How to Hold Students Accountable During Independent Reading

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While there is a dearth of experiments on independent reading, there are a slew of such studies on required self-selected reading. I've been critical of the quality of such studies in the past, though recent ones have been more rigorous and better reported (though their results haven't been that different).

The Importance and Use of Student Self-Selected Literature ...

Independent reading is an authentic and individualised practice that can support the explicit teaching undertaken during the whole group focus at the start of a reading lesson and provide opportunities for reflection at the lesson closure.

Independent reading - Department of Education and Training

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Students should be reading self-selected books of interest that are at least 1 to 1.5 reading levels above their current reading level. The amount of time spent in Phase 2 should increase over time, based on student readiness and self-regulation, until students are reading independently about 35-45 minutes per day.
