

## The Medicare Recovery Audit Contractor Program A Survival Guide For Healthcare Providers

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### The Medicare Recovery Audit Contractor

The Medicare Fee for Service (FFS) Recovery Audit Program's mission is to identify and correct Medicare improper payments through the efficient detection and collection of overpayments made on claims of health care services provided to Medicare beneficiaries, and the identification of underpayments to providers so that the CMS can implement actions that will prevent future improper payments in all 50 states.

Medicare Recovery Audit Contractors (RACs) A Guide for Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists The Medicare Recovery Audit Program was designed to identify and reduce improper payments. Five RACs are each responsible for identifying overpayments and underpayments in approximately one quarter of the country, divided geographically.

The Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) is a pilot program designed to determine whether the use of RACs will be a cost-effective means of adding resources to ensure correct payments are being made to providers and suppliers and, therefore, protect the Medicare Trust Fund. The demonstrations are currently in California, Florida and New York.

### Recovery Audit Contractors | CMS Innovation Center

Recovery Audit Contractors identify improper Medicare payments made on healthcare claims. These audits may result in the identification of Medicare overpayments and/or underpayments. Providers that may be reviewed include hospitals, physician practices, nursing homes, home health agencies, durable medical equipment suppliers and any other provider or supplier that bills Medicare Part A and Part B.

### Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) - JE Part A - Noridian

This project examined the cost of using private contractors, known as Recovery Audit Contractors (RACs), who were paid on a contingency fee basis to carry out this function. The demonstration project lasted three years (2005-2007). It originally focused on the three states with the largest Medicare utilization: California, Florida and New York.

### Recovery Audit Contractors | Council for Medicare Integrity

Recovery auditors (formerly known as Recovery Audit Contractors or RACs) are divided into jurisdictions, and are separate from the contract that CGS has to processing Medicare claims. ### Recovery Audit Program - CGS Medicare

The Part D Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) is a contractor that performs data analysis on Prescription Drug Events (PDE) submitted by Part D plan sponsors in order to detect improper payments. The RAC is paid a contingency fee for amounts recovered.

### The Recovery Audit Program and Medicare

Medicare does not pay for items or services to the extent that payment has been, or may reasonably be expected to be, made through a liability insurer (including a self-insured entity), no-fault insurer or workers' compensation entity (Non-Group Health Plan (NGHP). When an accident/illness/injury occurs, you must notify the Benefits Coordination & Recovery Center (BCRC).

The national Recovery Audit program is the product of a successful pilot program that utilized Recovery Auditors to identify Medicare overpayments and underpayments to health care providers and suppliers in randomly selected states.

### Recovery Audit Contractor (RAC) Program

The Medicare Parts C and D Recovery Audit Program was created to identify and correct past improper payments to Medicare providers and implement procedures to help the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), Medicare carriers, fiscal intermediaries and Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) implement actions that will prevent future improper payments.
