However, after the latest Windows Server updates install and reboot, we are unable to stop or restart the BFE service.

### **Can't stop Base Filtering Engine service on Windows Server ...**

The Base Filtering Engine (BFE) is a user-mode service (bfe.dll running in a svchost.exe process) that coordinates the WFP components. The principal tasks performed by BFE are adding and removing filters from the system, storing filter configuration, and enforcing WFP configuration security.
