FY2020 ICD-10-CM Guidelines

These are: 1. When coding, for greater accuracy, use both the alphabetic index and the tabular list to ensure that no errors are... 2. Always assign all the five digit ICD codes if they are available and use four and three digit codes only when no other... 3. Only use the NOS (other) and NEC ...

General Inpatient Coding Rules And Regulations ...

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For inpatient coding, the coding professional should assign procedure codes for all procedures that impact reimbursement and quality reporting, and ensure data is captured to meet the organization's needs as designated by the facility guidelines.

Evaluation and management (E/M) coding is the use of CPT ® codes from the range 99201-99499 to represent services provided by a physician or other qualified healthcare professional. As the name E/M indicates, these medical codes apply to visits and services that involve evaluating and managing patient health.

Inpatient procedures are coded on hospital claims using the ICD-10 Procedural Coding System, not the AMA's Current Procedural Terminology, 4th Edition, which is used for all clinician services. CMS requires all “significant” procedures to be coded by the hospital.

Procedure Coding System (ICD-10-PCS). These guidelines should be used as a companion document to the official version of the ICD-10-PCS as published on the CMS website. The ICD-10-PCS is a procedure classification published by the United States for

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classifying procedures performed in hospital inpatient health care settings.

Pediatric vaccines with counseling are coded per component. Each first component of a vaccine (Measles and Diphtheria in this case) are coded as one unit of 90460. Each additional component to the vaccine (mumps, rubella, tetanus and acellular pertussis) receive another 90461 for an additional component code.

These guidelines are based on the coding and sequencing instructions in the Tabular List and Alphabetic Index of ICD-10-CM, but provide additional instruction. Adherence to these guidelines when assigning ICD-10-CM diagnosis codes is required under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

The ICD-9-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting are used to assign codes reported on the UB-04. An IRF is considered a post-acute care facility, and conditions that are treated prior to
